Application for the 2019 BEC Regional Projects

Dear Member Association,

Badminton Europe would like to invite you to apply for the 2019 BEC Regional Projects funding, which you can follow on our official [Regional Project webpage](#).

Please be informed that the BEC Regional Projects 2019 are also opened to **para-badminton projects**. The para-badminton Regional Projects will not include a limit of age.

The aims of the BEC Regional Projects are:

- Encouraging MA's to collaborate together.
- Form a development initiative to enhance and raise the level of badminton in the different regions.
- Provide knowledge exchange possibilities.
- Create and establish long term training programmes/collaborations.

Activities

The project should be a collaboration of **a minimum of 3 Member Associations** from the same region, organised as one of the below listed activities:

- Training Camps for U13, U15, U17 and/or U19 players (or all ages for para-badminton Regional Projects)

For the 2019 BEC Regional Projects application it is essential that collaborating MA's confirm their agreement on collaboration at the time of applying. Badminton Europe is keen to ensure that cooperation between Member Associations take place

at all stages of planning through to implementation of the activity. **It is essential that ALL cooperating Member Associations confirm their participation by email with the organizing Member Association before submitting the project application form to Badminton Europe.**

Planning

Proposals should include the **main purpose** and **objective** of the 2019 BEC Regional Project, clearly detailing the **goals** of what the activity is intended to achieve. A good proposal will also include a strategy on how the goals and objectives will be met and indicate a timeline for when they are planned to be achieved. Projects should have a project leader or organiser. This person should be appointed by the Member Association.

2019 Project Funding

Badminton Europe will consider all applications and decide which Regional Projects are the most suitable to be supported in 2019. The decision will be made based on the relevance and short and long-term objectives of the proposed projects.

In 2019 Badminton Europe will support **up to 12 projects**, by allocating a support of up to **3000 EUR + shuttles** per project. The budget for the 2019 BEC Regional project support is 36 000 EUR + shuttles.

Badminton Europe funding will be allocated on a **participation basis**. The financial grant will be paid directly to Member Association(s). Payment will be made after submitting the requested documentation after completion of the activity. Should all cooperating Member Associations prefer the financial grant to be paid directly to the organising association, **please clearly state this in the application form.**

The timescale for the procedure

26 September 2018 - Distribution of invitation, application opens

12 November 2018 - Closing date for applications

19 November 2018 - Decision on the funding allocation – the information letter to be sent to the MA's
